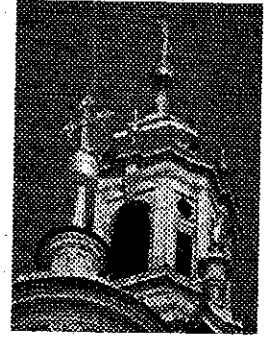


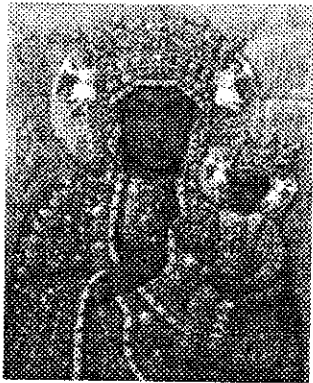

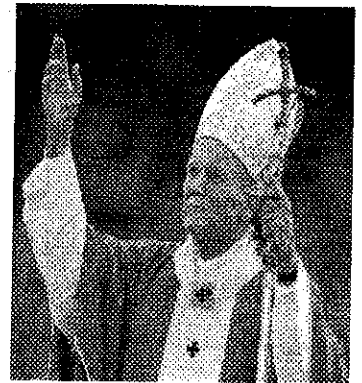

**Sept. 19, (Wednesday):** Depart the USA for an overnight flight to Warsaw, Poland on a scheduled airline

**Sept. 20, (Thursday):** Upon arrival in Warsaw meet your local European escort who will be with you throughout the tour. Board your luxury motor coach and transfer to your hotel. Lunch on your own in one of the restaurants in the city center. Take a mid-afternoon sightseeing tour of the city. (Sightseeing schedule today depends on the arriving flight schedule.) This evening enjoy a Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Warsaw (D)

**Sept. 21, (Friday):** Today travel northwest to Torun, the birthplace of Nicholas Copernicus. A guided tour of this fascinating city will include Old Town, Market Square, the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist and the House of Copernicus. Lunch on your own with some free time to explore. Travel back to Warsaw. Dinner on your own. Overnight Warsaw (CB)

**Sept. 22, (Saturday):** Depart Warsaw for Czestochowa with a visit to the Jasna Gora Monastery. The Pauline Monastery, has the famous Gothic painting of the Black Madonna. The icon, depicting the Mother of God with the Christ Child, is known as The Black Madonna of Czestochowa. Next, a guided tour of the monastery by one of the Pauline monks. *Late afternoon celebration of Mass at the Monastery Chapel in Czestochowa.* Dinner and overnight in Czestochowa. (Note that hotels are limited in Czestochowa and all are basic) (CB,D)

**Sept. 23, (Sunday):** Depart for Krakow with a stop in Pszczyna for a guided tour of the magnificent castle which is now a stately home. Time to visit Monumental Park in Pszczyna. Depart for Koboir for lunch at the Shooting Lodge at Promnice-Norma Residence. Travel to the Tyskie Brewery for an afternoon tour and a sampling of Polish beers. (Subject to confirmation and availability.) Transfer to Krakow and check into your hotel. Attend *Mass at the Church of Corpus Christi.* Dinner on your own. Overnight Krakow (CB,L)

**Sept. 24, (Monday):** Take a walking tour of Krakow including a view of Pope John Paul II's former residence, followed by a tour of St. Stanislaw on the Rock Church. The tour continues to Szeroka Street where "Schindler's List" was filmed. This evening enjoy dinner and Klezmer Music at a Jewish restaurant. Overnight in Krakow. (CB,D)

**Sept. 25, (Tuesday):** Today, enjoy a raft trip down the Dunajec River through the Pieniny Gorge and along the Polish-Slovak border, which is one of the greatest tourist attractions in Poland. The last trip lasts 2 or 3 hours, depending on the water level of the river. Lunch is on your own. Next visit Zakopane, Poland's Winter Capital, in the Tatras Mountains. Return to Krakow for dinner on your own. Overnight Krakow (CB)

**Sept. 26, (Wednesday):** Today is free to enjoy. You may want to shop in Cloth Hall for amber, picnic along the Vistula River, explore Krakow or take an **Optional tour:** An excursion to Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, a 17<sup>th</sup> century Benadine monastery, a favorite childhood place of prayer for Pope John Paul II, and the center of pilgrimages in Poland. After the tour transfer to Wadowice, the birthplace of Karol Wojtyla, the late Pope John Paul II, for a glimpse of life in a small Polish town. Tonight enjoy a Farewell Dinner with Folklore music. Overnight in Krakow (CB,D)

**Sept. 27, (Thursday):** Depart from Krakow for your return flight to the USA.
