The Annual CSA Appeal

I have already written to each household personally asking you to support this important collection that is taken up every year in the Archdiocese of Detroit. I beg you to be generous reminding you that anything over our goal of \$25,185.00 we collect will stay in our parish. But doing a little basic arithmetic, it has come to my attention that if we were to divide the goal up equally among all of 430 households, each one would need to pay only \$54.75 for us to meet our goal! That is a relatively painless amount, don't you think? As you know, if for some reason we do not make our goal we must withdraw the necessary funds from our operating account. This could make it difficult to pay our bills. At this point of the campaign 207 of our 430 families have donated \$23,395.75. Still 223 households have not responded and \$1789.25 is still need. We made it last year. I know we will do it again this year. Personally, I'm ready to pledge my fair share! How about you?
